




**Instructions** Front Side - (FrS), Reverse Side (RvS)

### 1. Make the handle and baste it to the bag fabric


Fold to the finish measurement and apply stitches.




2. With the front sides facing each other, fold bag fabric and sew sides, bottom and gusset



3. Make the shoulder strap and baste it to bag fabric



4. Turn it inside out. Fold the bag opening in three and apply stitches



5. Pull up handles and shoulder strap. Apply stitches around the bag opening to finish
