36cm (w – at opening) 28cm (bottom)

8cm (gusset)

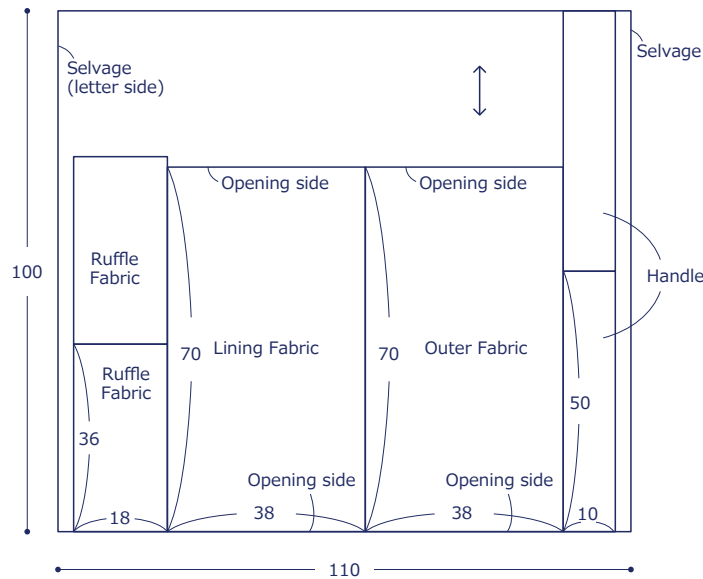
Materials

- Fabric: 110cm wide x 1m
- Waxed Cord: 0.3cm diameter x 1.8m

Fabric shown for this sample: EGX-9220-3C

Pattern and Cutting Layout

Unit: cm All raw edge.



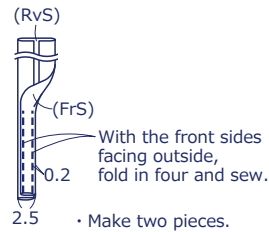
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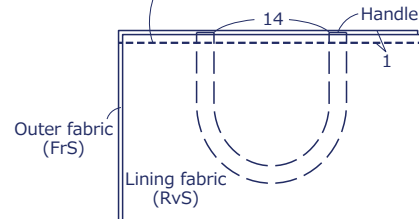
Instructions Front Side - (FrS), Reverse Side (RvS)

1. Make the handle



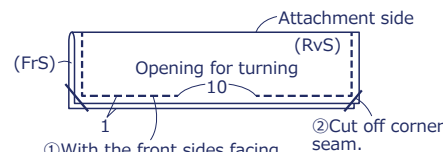
2. Make the bag body

- ① With the front sides facing each other, sew together the outer fabric and lining fabric at the opening side with a handle in between.



• Repeat the same process on the other side.

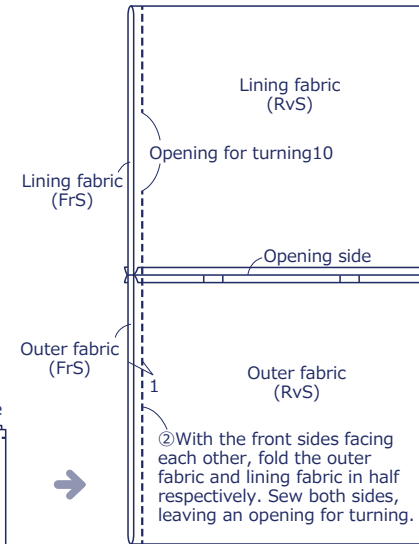
3. Make the ruffles



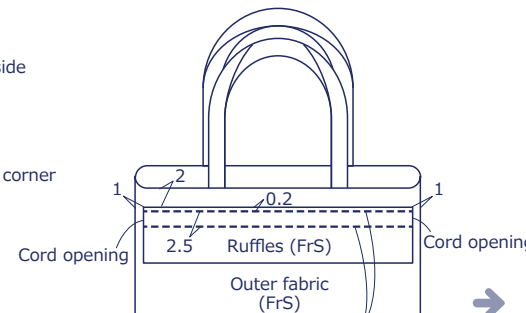
- ① With the front sides facing each other, fold in half and sew all three sides, leaving an opening for turning and attachment side unsewn.



- ③ Turn it inside out and apply stitches.
 - Make two pieces.



4. Finish the bag



- ③ Close the opening for turning.
