



Vest With Side Ribbons

Design & Work: Kokka Fabric

Size: M

Body Length: about 82.5cm

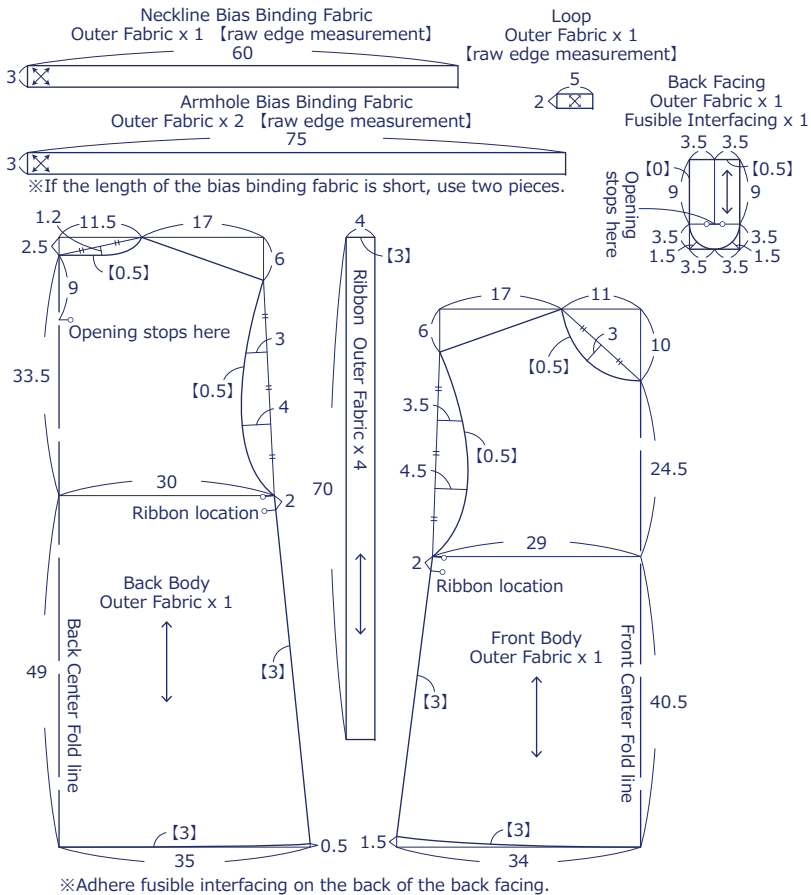
Materials

- Outer Fabric: about 100cm wide x 200cm
- Fusible Interfacing (light weight): about 90cm wide x 20cm
- Button: about 11.5mm wide x One piece

Fabric shown for this sample: YPA-56000-2A

Pattern

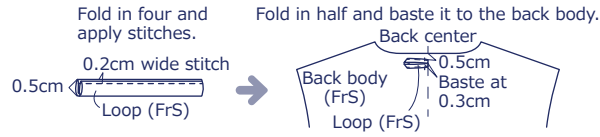
Unit: cm. [] denotes seam allowance.
Add 1cm seam when cutting the fabric unless specified otherwise.



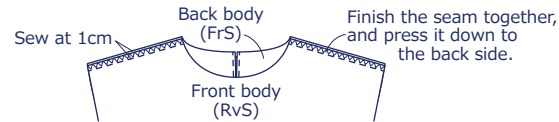
Instructions

Front Side - (FrS), Reverse Side - (RvS)

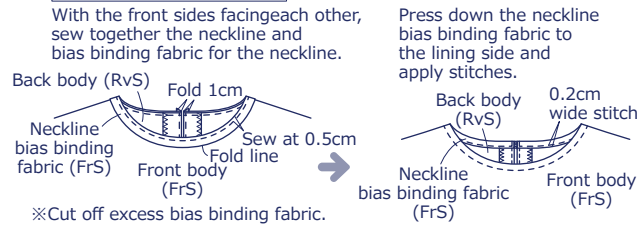
1. Make the loop and baste it to the back body



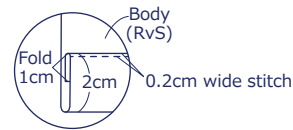
3. With the front sides facing each other, sew together the front body and back body at the shoulder



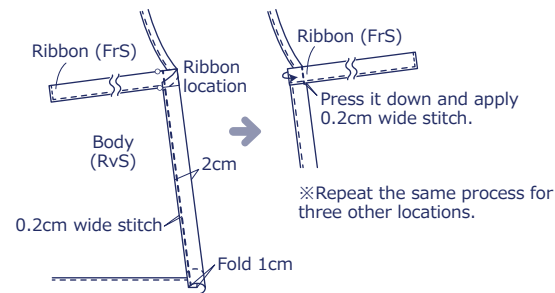
5. Finish the neckline



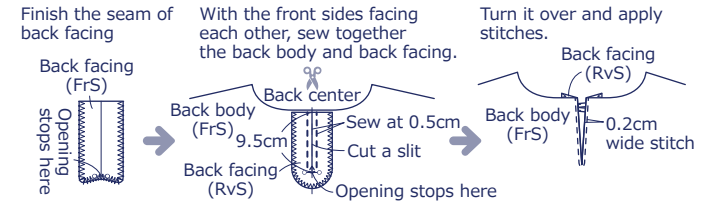
7. Fold the hem in three and apply stitches



9. Fold the side in three, place the ribbon in-between and apply stitches



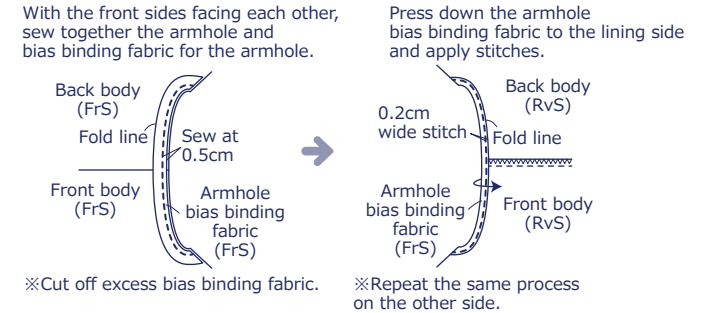
2. Finish the seam of back facing, and sew up to where the opening stops on the back body



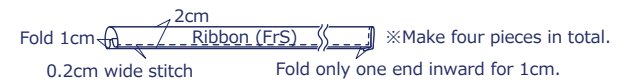
4. With the front sides facing outside, fold the bias binding fabric in half



6. Finish the armhole



8. Fold the cord in four and apply stitches



10. Attach the button on the back body to finish
