Instructions Front Side - (FrS), Reverse Side - (RvS)

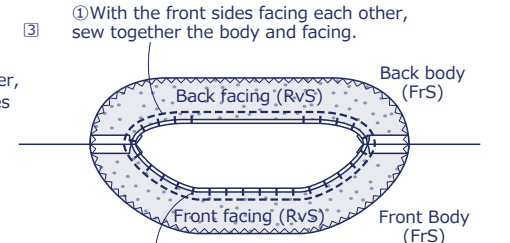
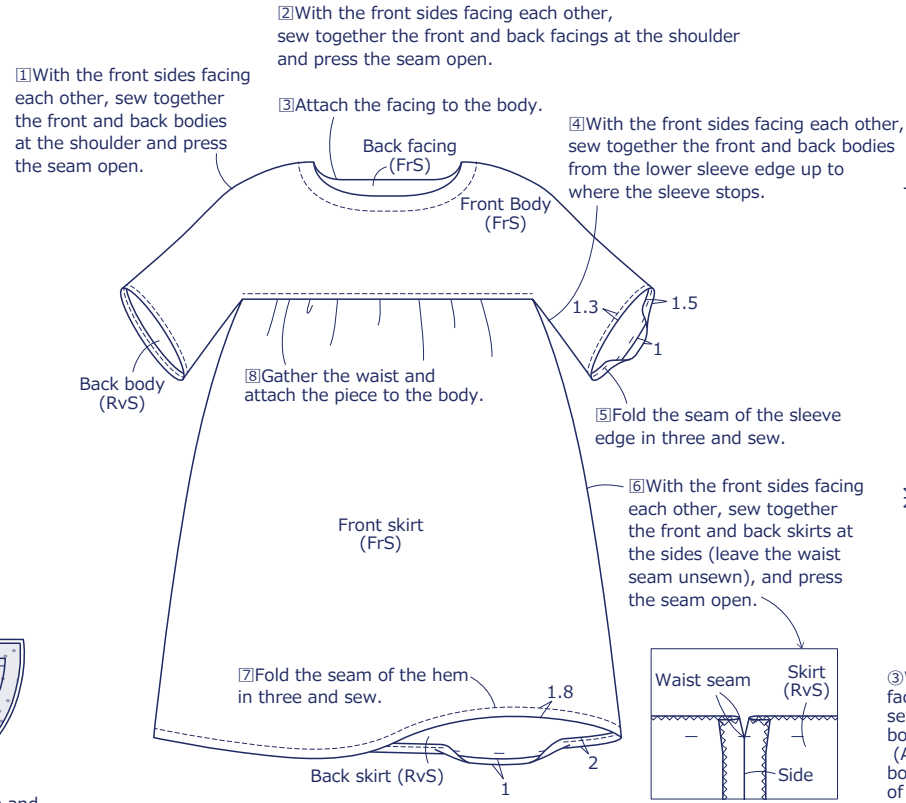
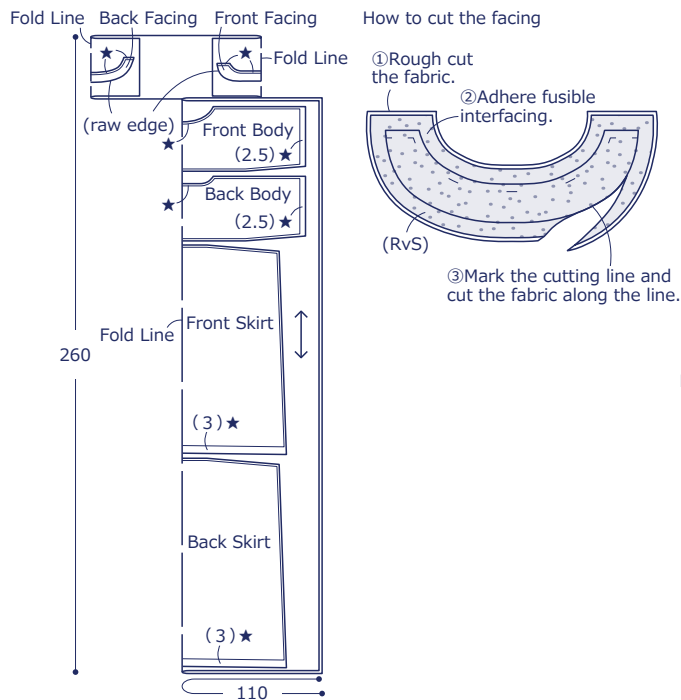
Materials

- Fabric: 110cm wide x 2.6m
- Fusible Interfacing: 80cm x 20cm

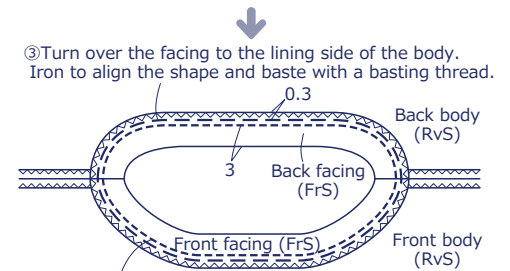
Fabric shown for this sample: YKA-500-1H

Cutting Layout

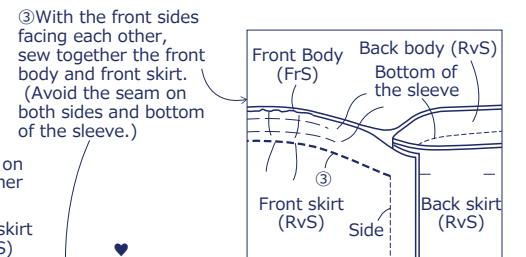
() denotes seam allowance Add 1cm seam allowance unless specified otherwise
Apply zigzag stitches on all the seam except for ★
Refer to the second sheet for pattern making and patterns



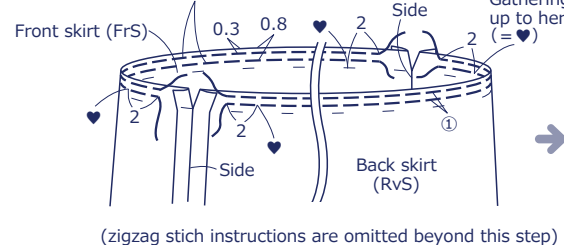
② Cut a slit on the seam.



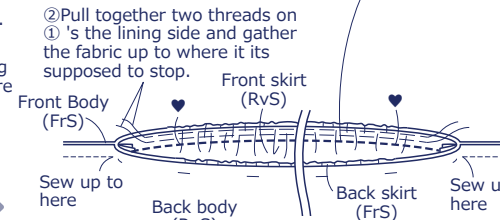
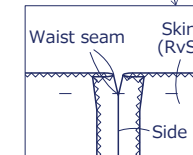
④ Sew to secure the facing and pull out the basting thread from ③.



⑧ Apply two rough stitches on the skirt's waist seam. It should go 2cm beyond where the gathering stops on each end.

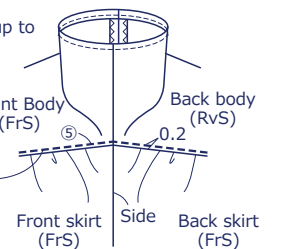


(zigzag stich instructions are omitted beyond this step)

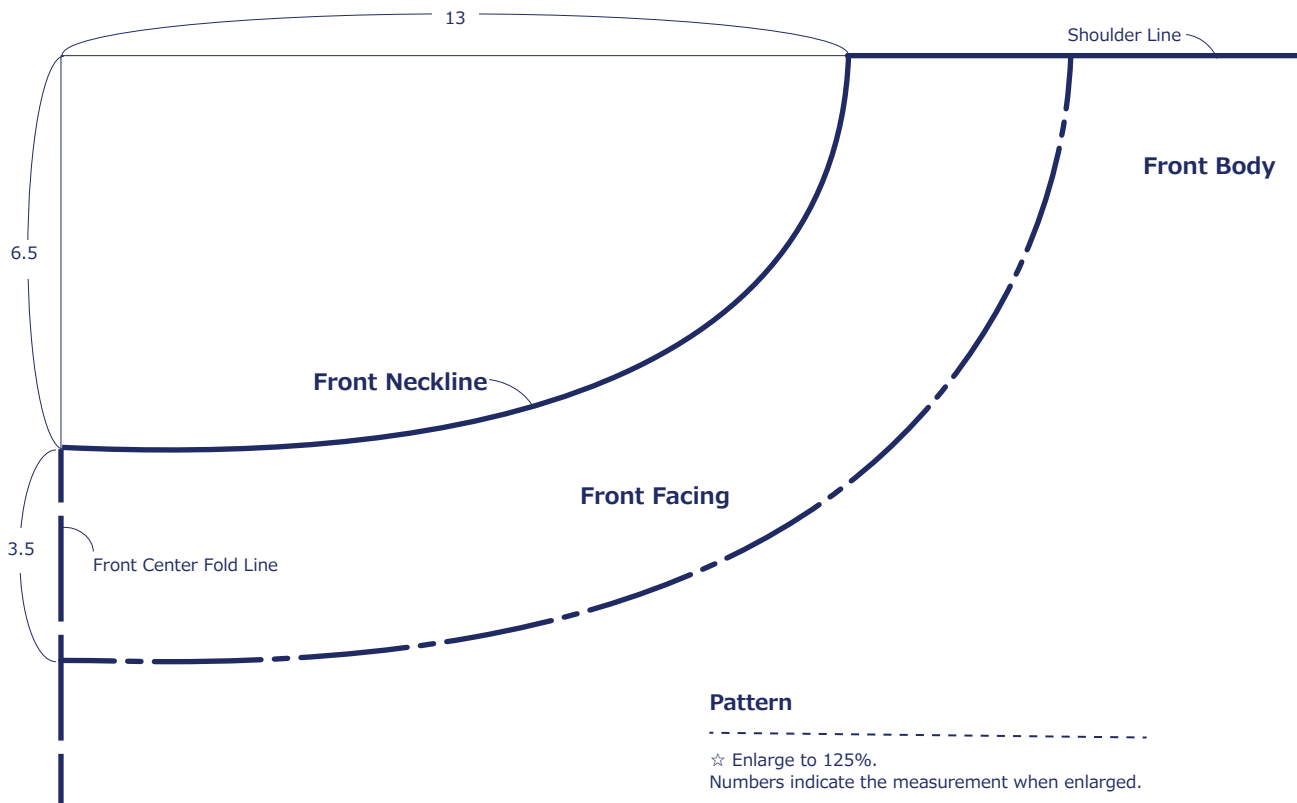
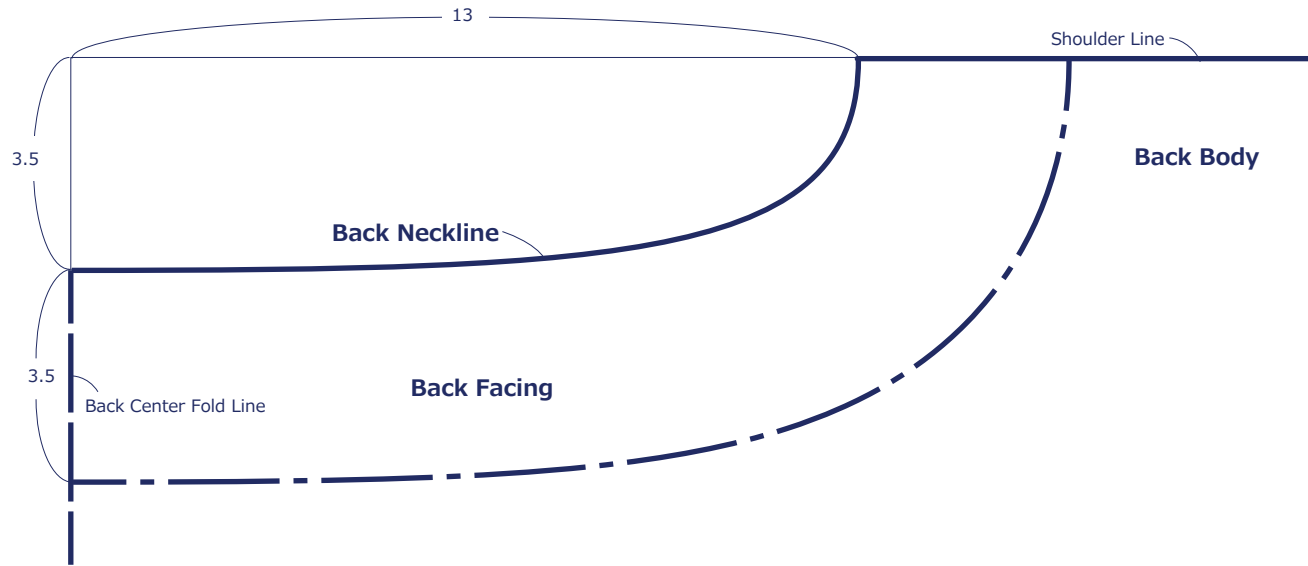


④ With the front sides facing each other, sew together the back body and back skirt, just like step ③.

⑤ Press down the seam to the body side. Apply stitches on the front and back respectively from one side to the other. (Avoid the seams on the side and bottom of the sleeve)



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Pattern

☆ Enlarge to 125%.
Numbers indicate the measurement when enlarged.
