-Size: 23cm (l) 33cm (w) 10cm (gusset)

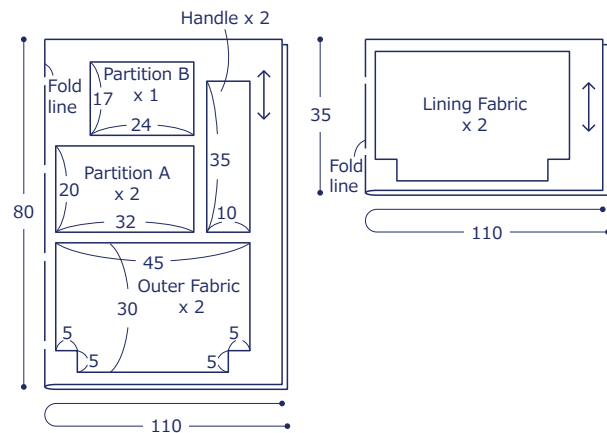
Materials

- Fabric (Outer Fabric, Partition, Handle): 110cm x 80cm
- Fabric (Lining Fabric): 110cm x 35cm
- Fusible Interfacing: 90cm x 80cm

Fabric shown for this sample: Outer Fabric EKX-98160-62D
Lining Fabric EKX-9800-800D

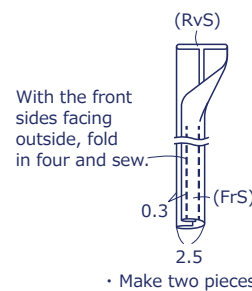
Pattern and Cutting Layout

Unit: cm All raw edge.
Cut lining fabric with same measurement as outer fabric.
Adhere fusible interfacing on the back of the outer fabric, partition and handle.

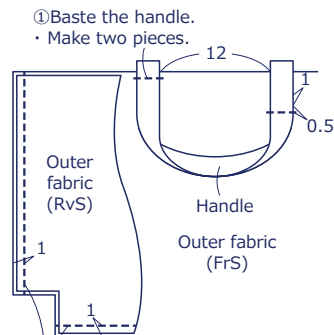


Instructions Front Side - (FrS), Reverse Side (RvS)

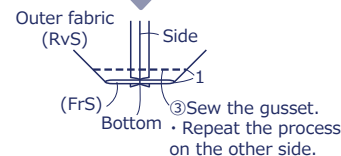
1. Make the handle



3. Make the outer bag



② With the front sides facing each other, sew together the outer fabrics at the sides and bottom.



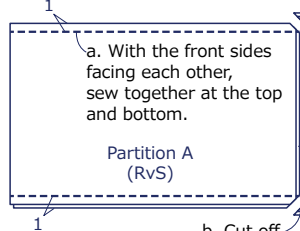
4. Finish the bag

① With the front sides facing each other, sew together the outer and lining bags all the way around the top.

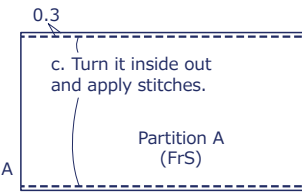


2. Make the lining bag

① Make the partition A.

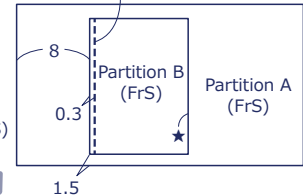


b. Cut off the corner seam.

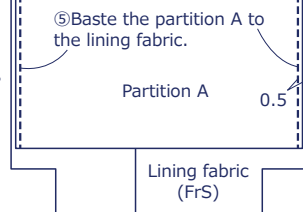
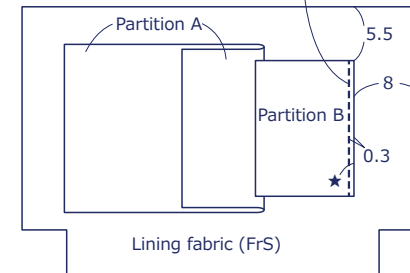


② With the front sides facing each other, fold the partition B and sew around the fabric, leaving an opening for turning.

③ Turn the partition B inside out and attach it to the partition A.

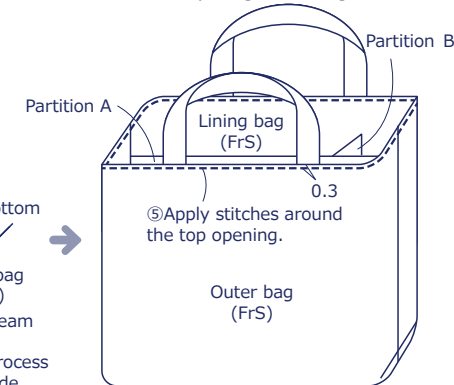


④ Attach the partition B to the lining fabric (avoid the partition A).



⑥ Repeat the process as in Step ③ - ② (Leave 10cm opening for turning at the bottom) and ③.

④ Turn it inside out and close the opening for turning.



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
